

D-14 : **Padlet** : participants introduce themselves

D-7: On-line meeting to specify stay details and Q&A session



- Collaborative workshop: participant introductions and presentation of their educational context (prepared before the stay)
- Modules focused on specific topics, led by experts
- Opportunity to visit a French school and observe how 'theoretical' elements are applied in practice (optional)
- Feedback using collaborative techniques such as Speed Resolutions



Two on-line month webinars on the session's topics to explore the knowledge, techniques and ideas acquired are implemented in different headmasters' contexts. Objectives:

- Identify remaining challenges and address them during the webinars
- Share how the acquired knowledge, techniques, and ideas are being applied in the participants' schools







A learning space will be included in the annual training program. Headteachers will be the main participants in our co-participatory scenario, forging connections with headteachers from around the world, while continuously interacting and exchanging best practices.
